File for free this tax season with the City of Phoenix Volunteer Income Tax Assistance Program (VITA)! There are three options available:

- Use our free tax software with help from a VITA volunteer. Individuals and families must make less than \$79,000/year.
- 2. Make an in-person appointment with an IRS-certified volunteer tax preparer. Individuals and families must make less than \$68,000/year.
- 3. File for free, online at MyFreeTaxes.com!
